



How to Register and Create your LinkedIn Profile

Step 1: Visit LinkedIn.com

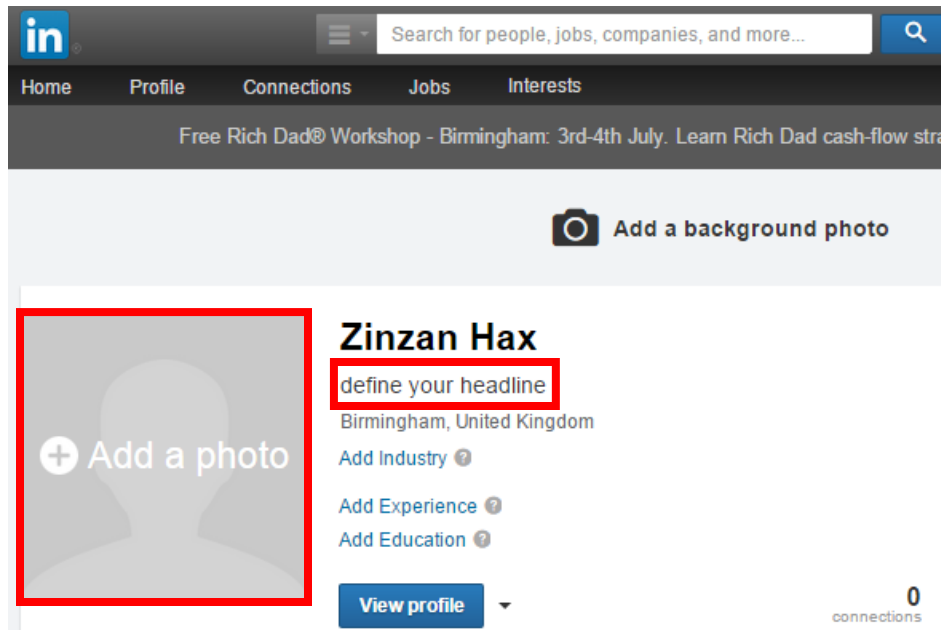
Step 2: Edit your profile

Step 4 Education

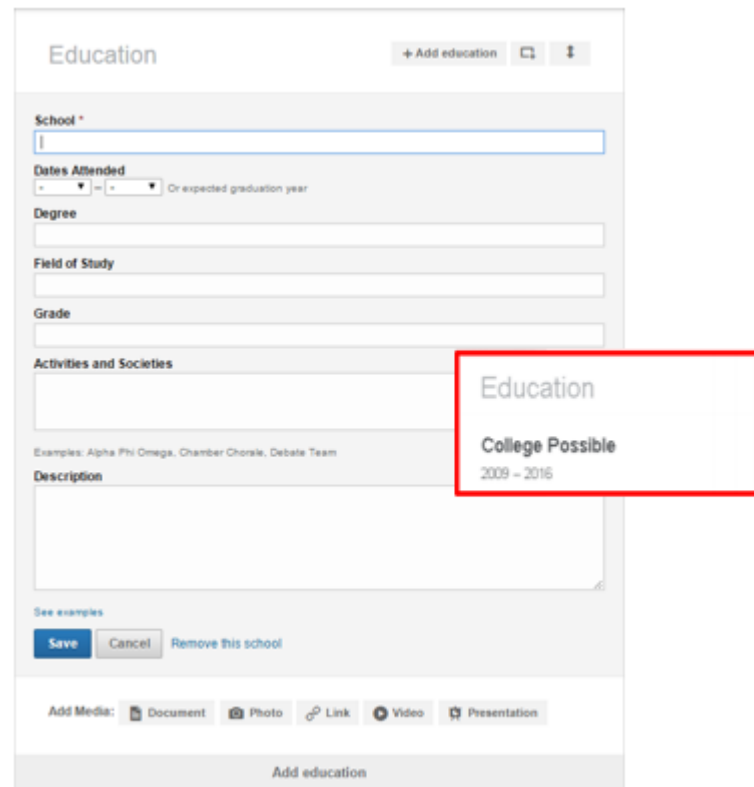
Click to add school and enter your high school information. Ignore “Degree and Field of Study” fields for now – save those for your future college!
