WHO WE SERVE



- + In 2017-18 **COLLEGE POSSIBLE** will reach nearly **2,000** students in **6** high schools and more than **130** colleges
- + Our students report an average family income of **less than \$28,000**
- + **98 percent** of our students earn admission to college
- + **93 percent** of Summer Bridge students go on to enroll in college
- + **90 percent** will be first-generation college students
- + **88 percent** are students of color
